PARTIAL HOSPITALIZATION PROGRAM NOW AVAILABLE

Partial Hospitalization Program (PHP)

The most intensive outpatient treatment available, PHP offers 10 full-day sessions of psychotherapy and other therapeutic services provided by a multi-disciplinary team. PHP can serve as a bridge between inpatient and outpatient care. Transportation may be provided to clients if needed.

ADDITIONAL OPIATE SPECIFIC PROGRAMS:

Medicated Assisted Treatment (MAT)

MAT is available for clients who meet criteria for opiate use disorder combined with Intensive Outpatient Opiate Specific treatment 4 days each week. Our prescribers use both buprenorphine and naltrexone to treat individuals in the program and individuals receive, medical, counseling, educational, and treatment services, in addition to the prescribed medication. Our MAT program provides a comprehensive, individually tailored program of medication and behavioral therapy. MAT medications relieve the withdrawal symptoms and psychological cravings that cause chemical imbalances in the body. This program provides a safe and controlled level of medication to overcome the use of an abused opioid.

Intensive Outpatient Treatment (IOP)

IOP consists of group therapy for those who have been living with their addiction for a longer period, and for whom daily life has been significantly disrupted. The composition of services is similar to that of Outpatient Treatment, though the frequency and duration of sessions is enhanced. The goal of Intensive Outpatient Treatment is to obtain and maintain long-term sobriety.
